



# WELCOME TO THE WORLD OF WALTON SUPER 8 MOVIES

If you are a regular purchaser and collector of Super 8 films, the name WALTON should need no introduction. For the newcomer to this fascinating pastime, a short preface to this catalogue may be helpful.

All Walton Super 8 subjects are derived from professional films most of which were originally made for Cinema showing. From famous producers such as M.G.M., United Artists, Rank, E.M.I., I.T.C., to name but a few, we have assembled a selection of famous titles spanning a period of 60 years from the unique comedies of Charlie Chaplin and the early sound films of Laurel & Hardy right up to present day major features.

With the exception of cartoons, some documentary films and old-time comedies, most films have been shortened by careful editing to produce an economical length and number of reels. Most features have been skilfully reduced to run for 72 minutes (or less in some cases) and many extracts – 2 reel (18 mins), 1 reel (9 mins) – have also been made available. These latter are very popular and often show the "highlights" of a particular story. There is a vast variety of subject matter providing the greatest possible choice for family entertainment.

If you are the owner of a silent projector, suitable versions are available of some subjects, but the choice is unfortunately more restricted than those with sound except for the "Classics of the Silent Screen".



### **SATURDAY EVENING PUSS**


**TJ13**
